OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: Fixation of Ceiling Prices for Scheduled formulations under Revised Schedule I (NLEM 2022) of DPCO, 2013 notified vide S.O. No. 5249(E) dated 11.11.2022.

The information may be furnished positively within 10 days from the issue of this O.M. in respect of formulations mentioned in Annexure-I, for enabling NPPA to take appropriate action for fixation of ceiling prices pursuant to the issue of Revised Schedule-I of DPCO, 2013.
